How to reach the BMBF in Bonn · Heinemannstraße 2 and 6



By car

A59 motorway

- to the “Bonn-Ost” interchange, then continue towards Bad-Godesberg
- take the “Bonn-Rheinaue” exit
- follow signs “Zu den Bundesministerien” into Heinemannstraße

A555 motorway

- to the “Bonn-Nord” interchange
- take the A 565 towards Siegburg/Bonn-Beuel as far as the “Beuel” junction
- then take the A 59 towards Königswinter as far as the “Bonn-Ost” interchange
- then take the A562 towards Bad Godesberg as far as the “Bonn-Rheinaue” exit
- follow signs “Zu den Bundesministerien” into Heinemannstraße

A565 motorway

- take the “Bonn-Poppelsdorf” exit
- continue along Reuterstraße via Willy-Brandt-Allee
- towards “Autobahn/Rheinaue” (underpass) onto Franz-Josef-Strauß-Allee
- follow signs “Zu den Bundesministerien” into Heinemannstraße

By rail

U 16 or U 63 (from Bonn main station “Hauptbahnhof”)

- direction Bad Godesberg to “Max-Löbner-Straße/Friesdorf” (approx. 10 minutes)
- approx. 100 m to the BMBF (pedestrian entrance on Max-Löbner-Straße)

U 66 (from Bonn main station or Siegburg station)

- direction Königswinter to “Robert-Schuman-Platz” (approx. 10 minutes from Bonn main station and approx. 45 minutes from Siegburg station)
- approx. 300 m to the BMBF

By air

From Konrad-Adenauer Airport

- take airport bus SB 60 to “Bonn-Hauptbahnhof” (main railway station)
- then continue by underground (U 16, U 63 or U 66) as described above

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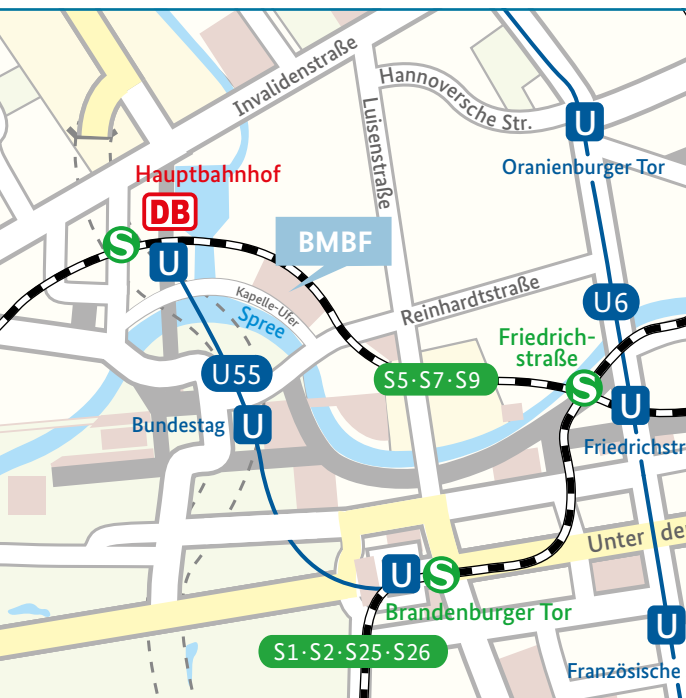

How to reach the BMBF in Berlin · Kapelle-Ufer 1



By rail

Berlin main station (“Hauptbahnhof”)

- approx. 250 m to the BMBF

By air

Arrival at Tegel Airport

- Airport bus TXL to “Hauptbahnhof” (main railway station) (25 minutes)
- approx. 250 m to the BMBF

Arrival at Schönefeld Airport

- “Regionalbahn” or “Regionalexpress” train to “Hauptbahnhof” (main station) (35 minutes)
- approx. 250 m to the BMBF
