The ARENA2036 (Active Research Environment for the Next Generation of Automobiles) Research Campus aims to establish the agile factory of the future. This will enable the automotive industry to implement smart, functionally integrated, multi-material, lightweight construction solutions and will contribute to shaping the success of technological change.
