An interdisciplinary team at the *STIMULATE* Research Campus in Magdeburg is developing minimally invasive methods to combat common oncological and neurological diseases. Their work will result in the establishment of rapid, efficient and secure diagnostic and treatment methods for as many diseases as possible.

STIMULATE's influence extends far beyond the borders of Saxony-Anhalt: The establishment of national and international companies on the research campus and the successful launch of a Bachelor's degree programme in medical engineering at the Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg are just two examples of its impact. The long-term goal of the research campus is to establish a "German Centre for Image-Guided Medicine", where research and industry collaborate side by side.

The research campus is funded by the Otto von Guericke University, Siemens Healthcare GmbH and the *STIMULATE* Association. Further partners can join the campus by becoming a member of the association. The research campus is located in Experimentelle Fabrik Magdeburg (Experimental Factory Magdeburg) on the campus of the Otto von Guericke University.
